** Depending on the amount and type of financial aid that recipients already have, the scholarship may only reduce the aid, not add to it. If selected as a scholarship recipient, it is the student's responsibility to look into how the award will affect other financial aid.*

** Award recipients will be required to submit a thank you letter within 2 weeks of award notification in order to receive the award.*

**Unless extenuating circumstances are present, the award will be divided between Fall 16 and Spring 17 semesters.*

**Students are only eligible for awards during semesters that they will be attending Michigan State University.*

**Students should also check with their major Department to see if additional scholarship funds are available through the department.*
